



Safety Tips for Private Residential Events

To ensure that your event is safe and successful here are some important safety related tips.

Food/Alcohol

- Food vendors / caterers should be permitted through the Riverside County Health Department.

Street Parking

- Vehicles should be legally parked:
 - Do not block fire hydrants or red curbs.
 - Do not block driveways.
 - Maintain adequate access for the Fire Department.
 - Any request for a road closure requires review and approval through the City.

Fire Safety

- A fire extinguisher should be readily available.
- The house address should be clearly visible from street.
- Exits should be easily openable, identifiable, and unlocked during the event.
 - Backyard gates should be unlocked if it is part of the exit pathway.
- If entertainment equipment (i.e., bounce house) is on site, all electrical cords must be secured and meet electrical code requirements.
- If open flame devices are utilized (BBQ, Tiki Torches, fire pits, portable heaters, etc.) adequate clearance shall be provided near combustible material and guests from the heat source.
- Decorations should not be made of flammable material or set in the pathway of exits.
