Welcome! We would like to thank you for your interest and participation with the Canyon Lake Emergency Preparedness Committee (CLEPC). CLEPC meetings are held the first Thursday of each month (except July, August, and December) in the Canyon Lake City Hall Council Chamber, at 6:30 p.m. Reminder notices are sent via email the week before each meeting.

There are several ways for you to participate in CLEPC. For those looking to be an active participant, your membership process will include the following:

- **Attend a CLEPC meeting and receive an information packet** - The packet you'll receive describes various positions that you might be interested in, based on your skills, experience, and preferences.
- **Complete New Member Registration form** - Identifies your contact info and your chosen level of participation. Members have the option to participate in only monthly meetings to learn disaster preparedness for themselves and their families, or volunteer in special areas of service like Care & Shelter, Communications Center (EOC), Damage Assessment, and Casualty Collection Center.
- **Return completed form to Canyon Lake City Hall** - You'll be added to an email distribution list for receiving information about monthly meetings, upcoming programs, CERT classes, FEMA courses, and other pertinent information.
- **Complete a livescan check at Speedy Vehicle Registration (FREE)** - All new CLEPC participants are required to complete a basic background check with the State of California. To do so, the City of Canyon Lake has prearranged livescans with Speedy Vehicle Registration, located at 361 Railroad Canyon Road, Suite #B, in Lake Elsinore. Present your purpose, provide proper ID showing residence in Canyon Lake, complete the livescan check, and the results will be sent to the City of Canyon Lake.
- **Obtaining your CLEPC Identification badge** - Upon receipt of a passing livescan result, you will be notified by the City with instructions on how to obtain your CLEPC identification badge at the POA's main office.

Again, thank you for your interest in the Canyon Lake Emergency Preparedness Committee. We look forward to meeting you at our next committee meeting.
